
- Only full-time students enrolled in a government recognised educational institution

- Fixed retail price per market, varying between US\$4 and US\$25 with an average of US\$10
- Next to ISIC, 2 additional cards:
 - International Teacher Identity Card (ITIC)
 - International Youth Travel Card (IYTC)
 - ISIC card representing 98% of card sales



ISIC = The Only Provider of Global Online Student Verification

- Only full-time students enrolled in a government recognised educational institution are eligible; focus is on tertiary students
- SIC card is valid for 12 to 16 months → Expiration date so benefits cannot be claimed post-graduation
- Each ISIC card has a unique serial number which is tracked
- All cards are registered in ISIC's central cardholder database
- 24/7 student status verification in real time via web services → example partnership with Microsoft = ISIC is one of Microsoft's online partners to verify student status






ISIC Online Benefit Example

90 days free English Online Learning with EF Education First

- From the global website or any local ISIC site click on EF Education First benefit to go to the online verification page
- After successful verification, cardholder is emailed a voucher
- Cardholder receives the email sent from ISIC with their personal voucher code
- Directed to EF's website and uses the voucher code to redeem the special benefit
